1. Exam Stages

SSC JE (Junior Engineer) exam is conducted in two stages:

1. Computer-Based Test (CBT 1)
2. Computer-Based Test (CBT 2) - Only for selected candidates

2. SSC JE CBT 1

| Subject | No. of Questions | Marks | Time |
|---|------------------|-------|---------|
| General Intelligence & Reasoning | 50 | 50 | 2 hours |
| General Awareness | 50 | 50 | 2 hours |
| General Engineering (Civil/Mechanical/Electrical) | 100 | 100 | 2 hours |

Total: 200 questions, 200 marks, 2 hours

Marking Scheme:

- 1 mark for each correct answer
- 0.25 marks deducted for each wrong answer

3. SSC JE CBT 2

| Subject | No. of Questions | Marks | Time |
|---|------------------|-------|---------|
| General Engineering (Civil/Mechanical/Electrical) | 300 | 300 | 2 hours |

Key Points:

- CBT 2 is objective type, focused only on engineering subjects.
- Marks from CBT 1 and CBT 2 are combined for final selection.
